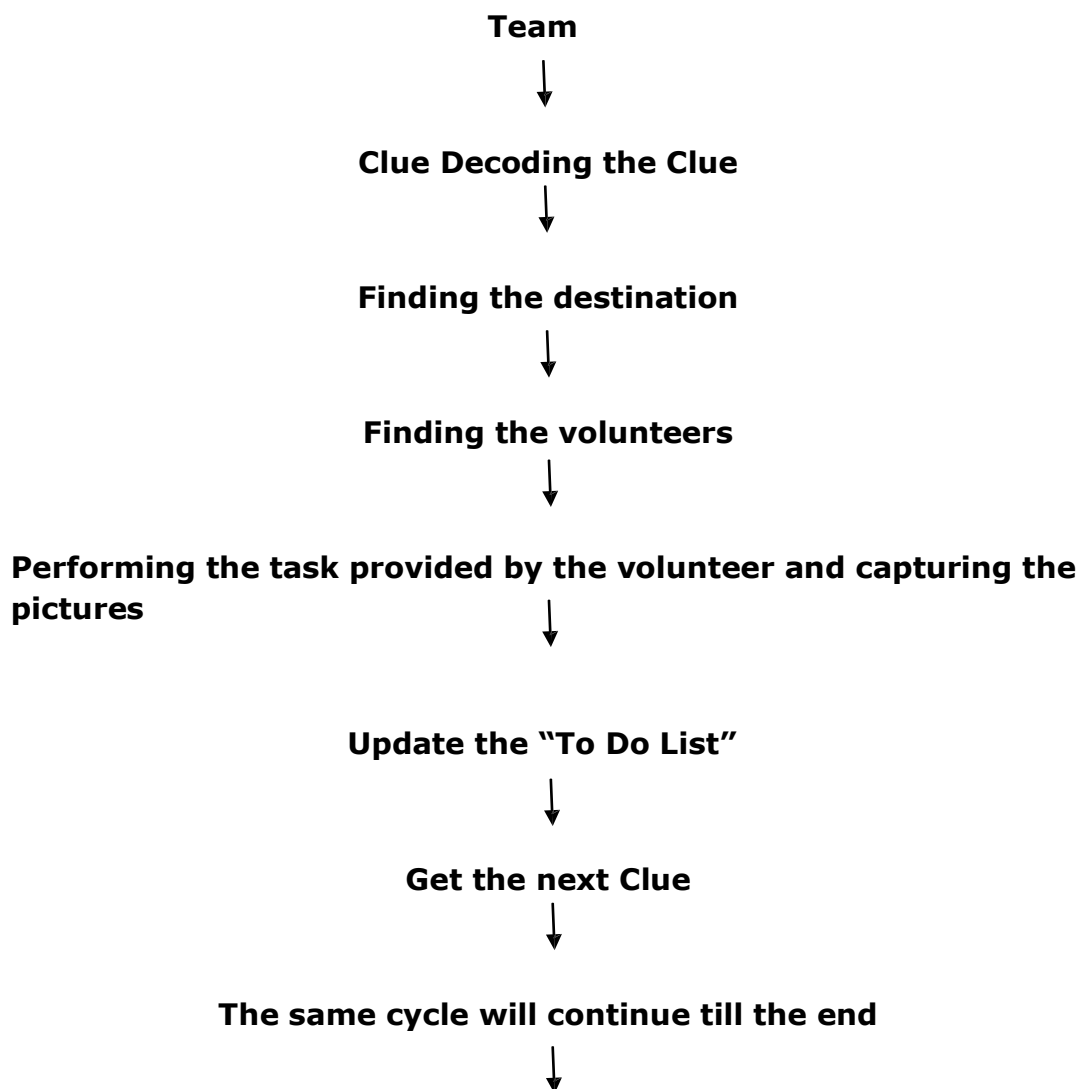

Rules and Regulations:

- All the teams will have to register themselves within prescribed time limit and the entries are purely based on first come first serve basis.
- Each team will have to mention the name of the person who shall be leading the team. Any further correspondence will be done with him.
- It shall be the responsibility of all the team members to adhere to traffic rules very strictly, in case any of the team members is found breaking the traffic rules the whole team shall stand disqualified. Wearing helmet is compulsory and valid Driving License is compulsory for the person who is driving the vehicle.
- All the team will be provided with a **"To do List"**, it will be the responsibility of the team leader to maintain and update the list till the end.
- Every time team decodes the clue, it's the responsibility of team leader to get the To-Do list verified and signed by Volunteer so available at the destination.
- The thrust of the game lies in capturing the moments of the game, volunteer shall give you a task to perform and teams will have perform the same. It is compulsory to capture the images while performing the task. Team will be given next clue only after an image has been captured and the same is seen by volunteer.
- Only fair game is permissible, any team found using any sort of unfair means will be disqualified.
- Expenses incurred shall not be reimbursed in any case. Petrol expenses shall not be reimbursed in any case.
- Teams will be provided light snacks during the journey. All the participants are requested to have a bag to carry and preserve the food till the required time.
- In any of the unforeseen situation the management has the right to change the terms and condition of the game and the same will be communicated to team leader.
- We believe that each team deserves to win; hence we have provided a lifeline which is known as **"Tossing a coin"** whereby each team will have an equal opportunity to conquer the treasure.
- Each team will get **four tosses** throughout the treasure hunt **which are purely based on luck**. The right to exercise this option lies with each team if they are unable to decode the clue. This clause has been inserted with the intention that there remains an equal opportunity for all the teams to perform outstandingly and get the biggest treasure.
- At the same time, if there is a tie i.e. if at the end two teams' reaches together then the team who has used lesser no of lifelines shall be construed as winner.

- As the game is team based so no individual and on the spot registration will be entertained. Over and above to this, **each team must consist of at least 4 candidates and maximum 6 candidates.**
- All the registration forms along with declaration and prescribes fees are to be handed over physically to Mr Piyush Patel or any relevant authority at 2nd floor of ICAI Bhavan, Naranpura.
- Declaration will state that that in case of any mishap during the treasure hunt, then in such case the institute shall not be liable in any circumstances. And it will have to be duly signed by all the members of the team.
- Further the contest is open for IPCC as well as FINAL student.
- The following is the hierarchy that every team is bound to follow.
